Parent signature on the reverse side and deposit of \$500.00 are required to process this application.

CAMP TUITION - A deposit of \$500.00 is required to process the camper's application. A second payment of \$500.00 is due on or before March 15th. The balance is due on or before April 30th of the current camping year. Accounts with balances that remain unpaid after April 30th will forfeit all tuition discounts and may be cancelled at the discretion of the camp.

REFUNDS
Campers enrolling for their first summer at Lake Greeley Camp are extended our First-Time Camper Promise. This promise provides for the refund of camp tuition for the days a camper leaves camp early. Tuition refunds are based on the actual session the camper attends camp. For instance, if a camper is enrolled for the full season and leaves camp at the end of the first-half session, the first-half session tuition is charged, not one-half of the full season tuition. If a cancellation of enrollment occurs prior to the start date of the enrolled session, the \$500.00 deposit and any additional payments will be refunded less a \$100.00 administrative fee. All refunds are made after the conclusion of the summer camp season, but before September 30, 2012.
No allowance or reduction of tuition will be made for the late arrival of a camper.

CANTEEN FUND - The charge for the camper's canteen fund is the only mandatory expense charged in addition to the camp tuition. The canteen fund covers the camper's daily canteen (camp store) allowance, one camp t-shirt, transportation for all off-camp trips, subscription to the Camp's newsletter, winter reunion admission fees, and unlimited access to the Camp's summer photo web page. The canteen fund charge is \$200.00 for the full season, \$150.00 for a six week session, \$100.00 for a half season, and \$50.00 for a mini session. Every camper is required to pay the appropriate canteen fund charge. Since the cost of coverage exceeds the amount charged, there is never a refund of the canteen fund expense.

CAMPER TREATMENT AUTHORIZATION & MEDICAL INSURANCE - Campers are required to carry medical insurance. Certain illnesses or injuries are referred by the Camp's Infirmary Staff to outside medical professionals whose fees are not covered by the camp tuition or the canteen fund. In-house infirmary medical care is provided as part of the camp tuition. If, in the judgment of the camp directors, it is necessary to use outside medical, surgical or dental aid for the camper's health, the parent(s) or legal guardian hereby authorizes the Camp to obtain this medical care. The parent(s) or legal guardian agrees to pay for the medical services provided whether or not the medical expense is covered by the parent's or legal guardian's insurance policy.

BUS AND BAGGAGE SERVICE (optional) - Lake Greeley Camp provides bus and baggage transportation four times during the camping season: 1). to camp on opening day; 2). from camp at the end of the first half session; 3). to camp at the beginning of the second half session; and 4). from camp at the end of the full season and the second half session. Our bus and baggage transportation services New York, New Jersey, Philadelphia, and Baltimore. The specific pick-up and drop-off locations are determined in late spring. The charge for this service is \$75.00 each way or \$140.00 round trip except the Baltimore stop. The Baltimore bus and baggage service is \$85.00 each way or \$160.00 round trip. The camper is limited to one dufflebag and one trunk. If you request this service, a Bus Transportation Request Form must be completed.

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION (optional) - Lake Greeley Camp provides transportation to and from two international airports: Newark Liberty International Airport and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre International Airport. If you request this service, an Airport Transport Itinerary Form must be completed. Please call our Moscow, PA office for fees.

LINEN RENTAL (optional) - The camp tuition includes a weekly laundering of the camper's clothes and linens. If the parent desires, the camp can supply the camper with the Camp's blankets, sheets, and pillowcases. This rental service is an optional expense. Pillows, towels, and washcloths are not available from the camp and should be brought to camp by the camper whether or not the linen service is elected. The linen charge is \$100.00 for

CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT:

1. Lake Greeley Camp reserves the right to dismiss, in its sole discretion, any camper, without a refund, who violates camp rules and regulations or whose condition, conduct, influence or behavior is deemed unsatisfactory or detrimental to the best interests of the Camp or his/her fellow campers.
2. Lake Greeley Camp strives to provide positive camp experiences for children with various needs whenever possible. However, Lake Greeley Camp does not provide programs that are rehabilitative or therapeutic in nature and does not specialize in serving children with special needs, including children with severe emotional, social, or behavioral difficulties. Please provide information (attach a separate sheet) regarding your child's special needs, including any disabilities, disorders, or medical conditions with this application form. It is important to determine if Lake Greeley Camp is appropriate for your child prior to attending camp. Failure to provide adequate information prior to your child attending camp may result in the camper being sent home without a refund. Lake Greeley Camp cannot accept the children who do not have the promise of living cooperatively with others.

3. I understand and certify that my child's participation in Lake Greeley Camp and its activities (on or off-camp) is completely voluntary and I have familiarized myself with the Camp's program and activities in which my child will be participating. I recognize that certain hazards and dangers are inherent in the Camp's programs particularly, but not limited to horseback riding, lake and pool swimming, water skiing, rock climbing, back packing, hiking on mountain trails, cabin overnights, canoe trips, circus arts, flying trapeze, gymnastics, high and low ropes course, zip line, cycling on mountain trails and public roads, land and water sports, athletic competition including bodily contact and contact with equipment and balls, intercamp games, lacrosse, baseball, archery, riflery, skateboarding and inline skating, use of power tools and equipment in certain creative arts activities, and travel in camp-owned and leased vehicles. I acknowledge that, although Lake Greeley Camp has taken safety measures to minimize the risk of injury to camp participants, the Camp cannot ensure nor guarantee that the participants, equipment, premises and/or activities will be free of hazards, accidents, or injuries. I recognize these risks and hereby assume these risks and agree to hold harmless and hereby release Lake Greeley Camp, its directors, owners, agents, and employees from all liability for loss, damage, injury, or illness to the camper or camper's property related to his/her participation in the Camp program. I have instructed my child in the importance of knowing and abiding by the Camp's rules, regulations, and procedures for the safety of Camp participants, the requirement that campers attend scheduled activities and remain supervised at all times, and my child has agreed to do so.
4. Lake Greeley Camp is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost or damaged by fire, theft, or laundry.
5. Permission is given to use pictures or video footage of the camper in our camp brochure or other advertising.
6. A finance charge of 1.5% per month (18% annually) will be applied to all outstanding debts. Accounts which have not been paid within 90 days of billing will be subject to attorney collection fees.
7. I agree that all disputes arising under this agreement and/or from my use of the facilities at Lake Greeley Camp shall be litigated exclusively in the court of Common Pleas of Pike County, Pennsylvania or in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania. In the event that the Camp is successful in any litigation, it is agreed that the losing party will reimburse the Camp for all attorney fees and costs of litigation.
8. The parent hereby states that the camper is in good health and has no abnormal physical or mental handicaps unless otherwise indicated on the aforementioned attached sheet. The parent hereby states that the camper is of sufficient maturity to properly care for his/her hygiene and participate in the Camp's program.

If this application is signed by one parent, I acknowledge that I am also acting as the agent of the other parent with authority to enroll my child at Lake Greeley Camp and to execute this agreement on his/her behalf. I recognize that Lake Greeley Camp relies upon the representations made in this application in accepting this enrollment.
